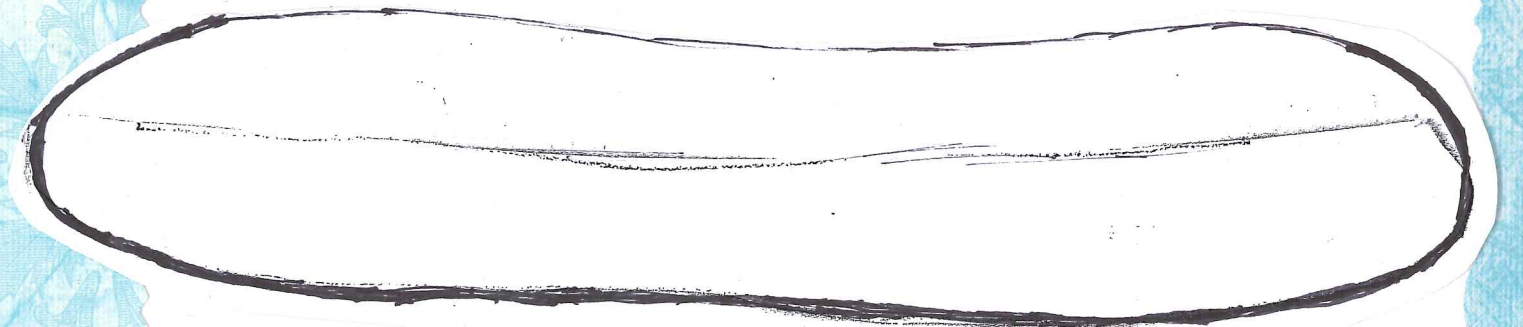
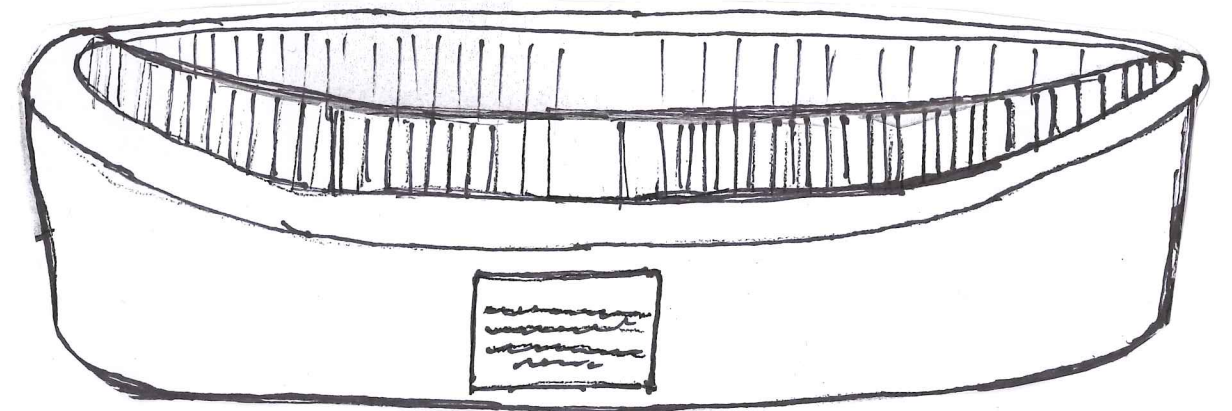
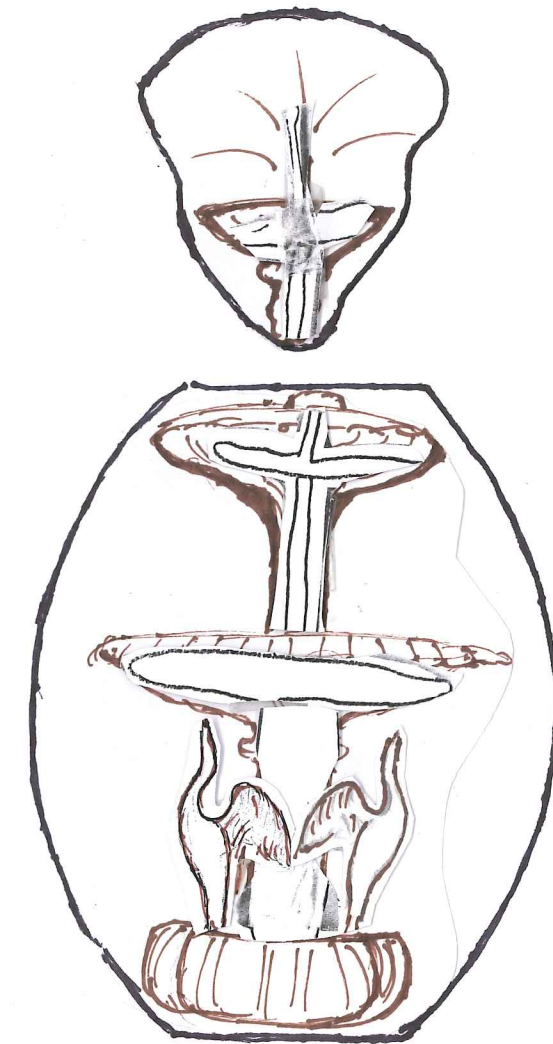
The Cooper Fountain

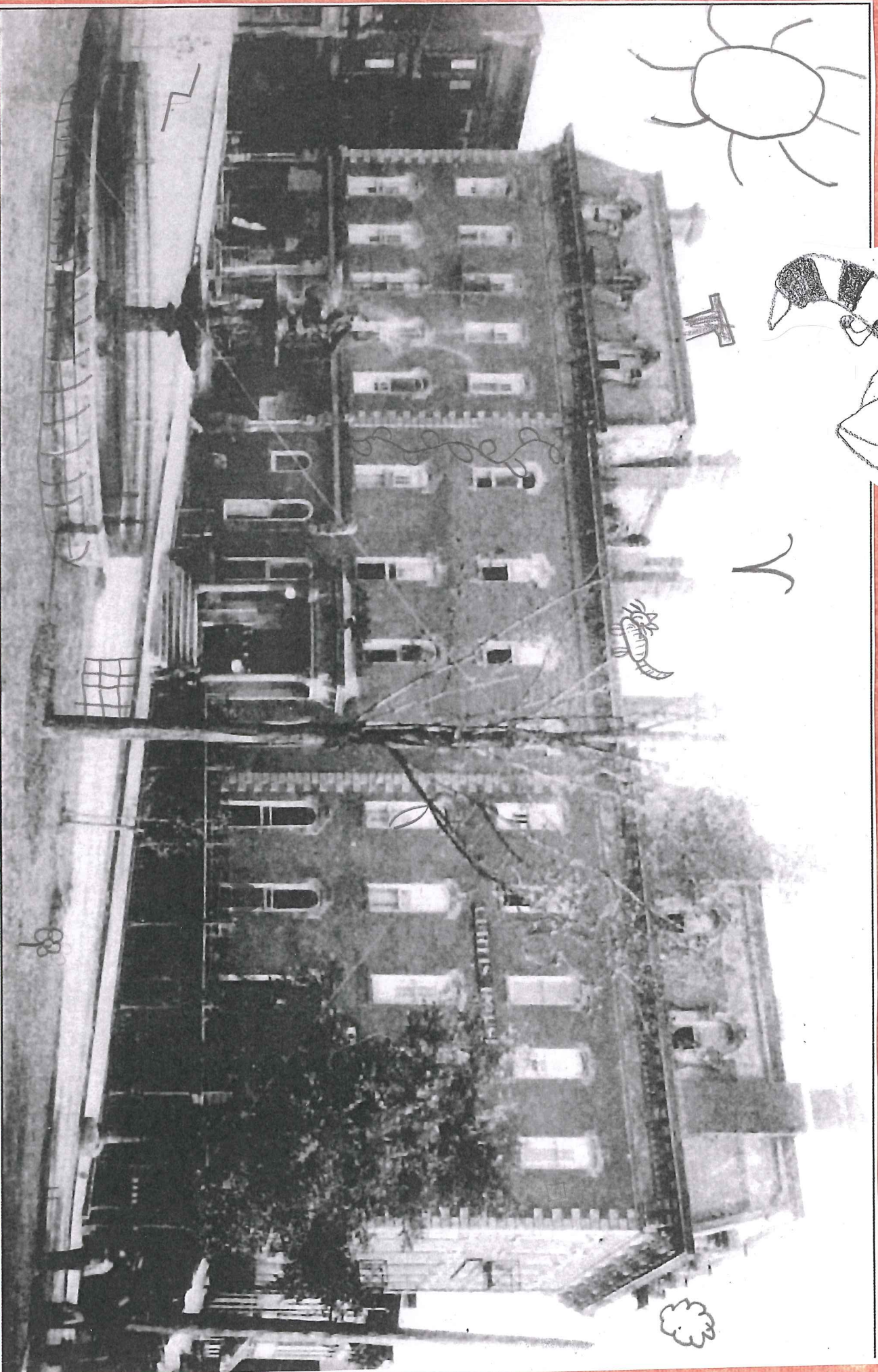
The Cooper Fountain is on the Public Square. The reason why the fountain is named "Cooper Fountain" is because Charles and Elias Cooper gave the fountain to Mount Vernon. For awhile the city had an aquarium in the fountain to get more people to come to town. It was not an aquarium for very long. The Cooper Fountain is a historical Mount Vernon monument.



Make a mobile!

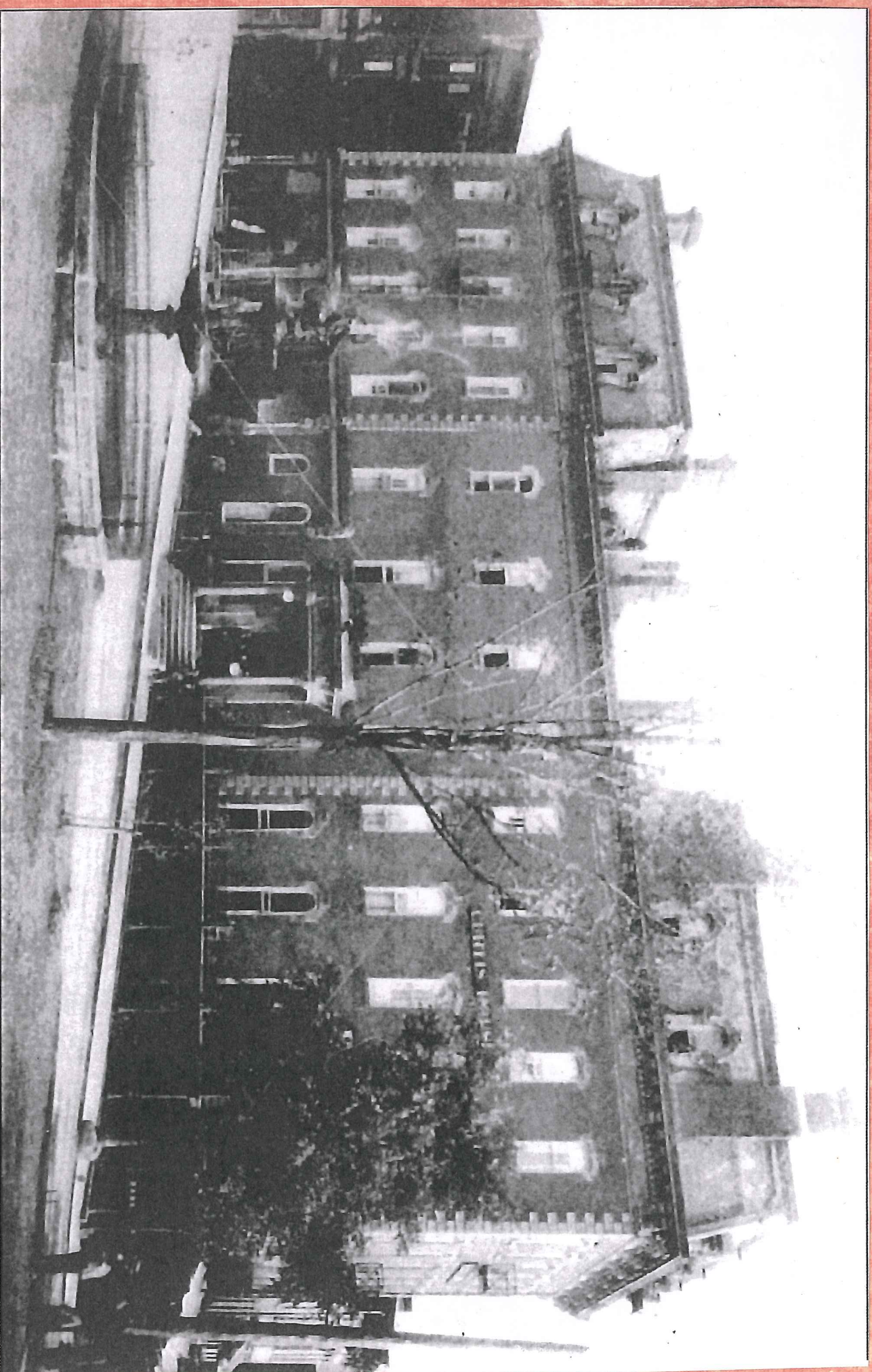
Paint or color the fountain pieces however you choose, then cut them out. Glue matching pieces to either side of the stick. Hang it with the piece of string.

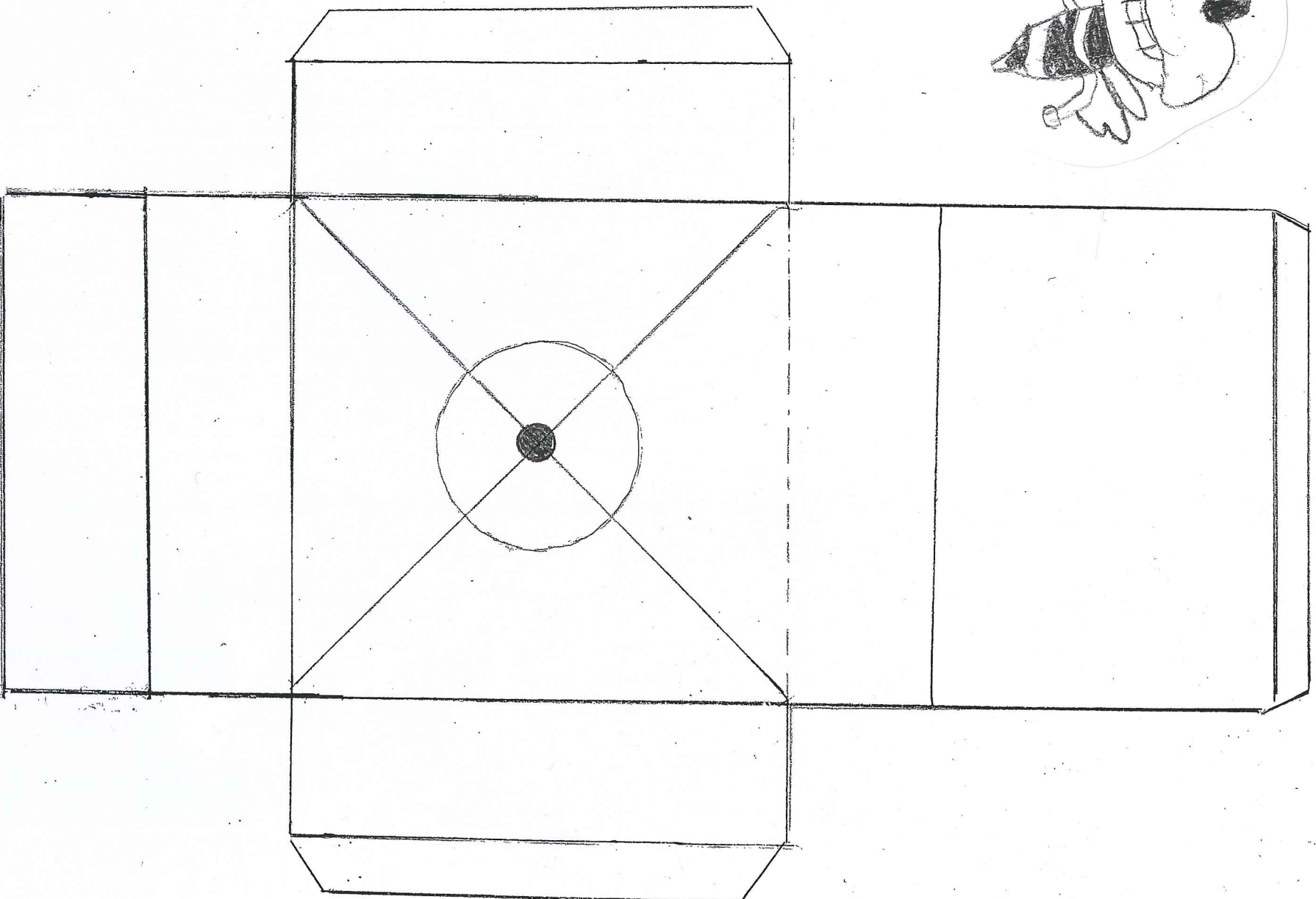
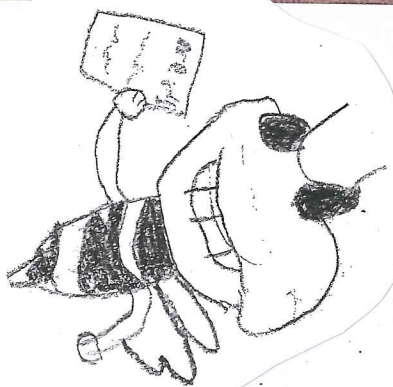




The Curtis Hotel has been in three different buildings at the same place. The first hotel had 73 rooms and 3 floors. The first hotel was built almost 140 years ago!

Find what makes the top picture different from the bottom picture!

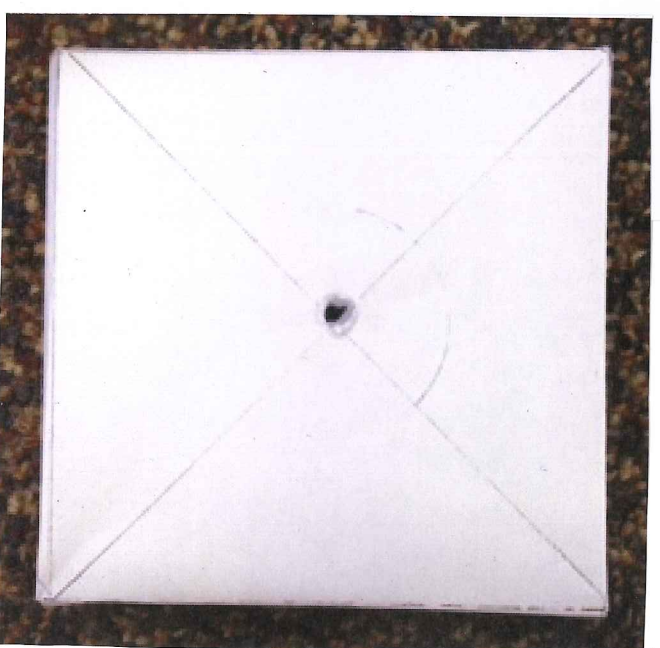




The Republican Newspaper

The Newspaper building was made in the 1900s. You could read The Republican Newspaper in the early part of the century.

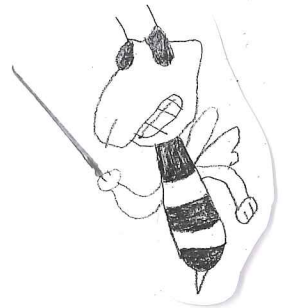

C. Triangle *The triangle was not always played.*

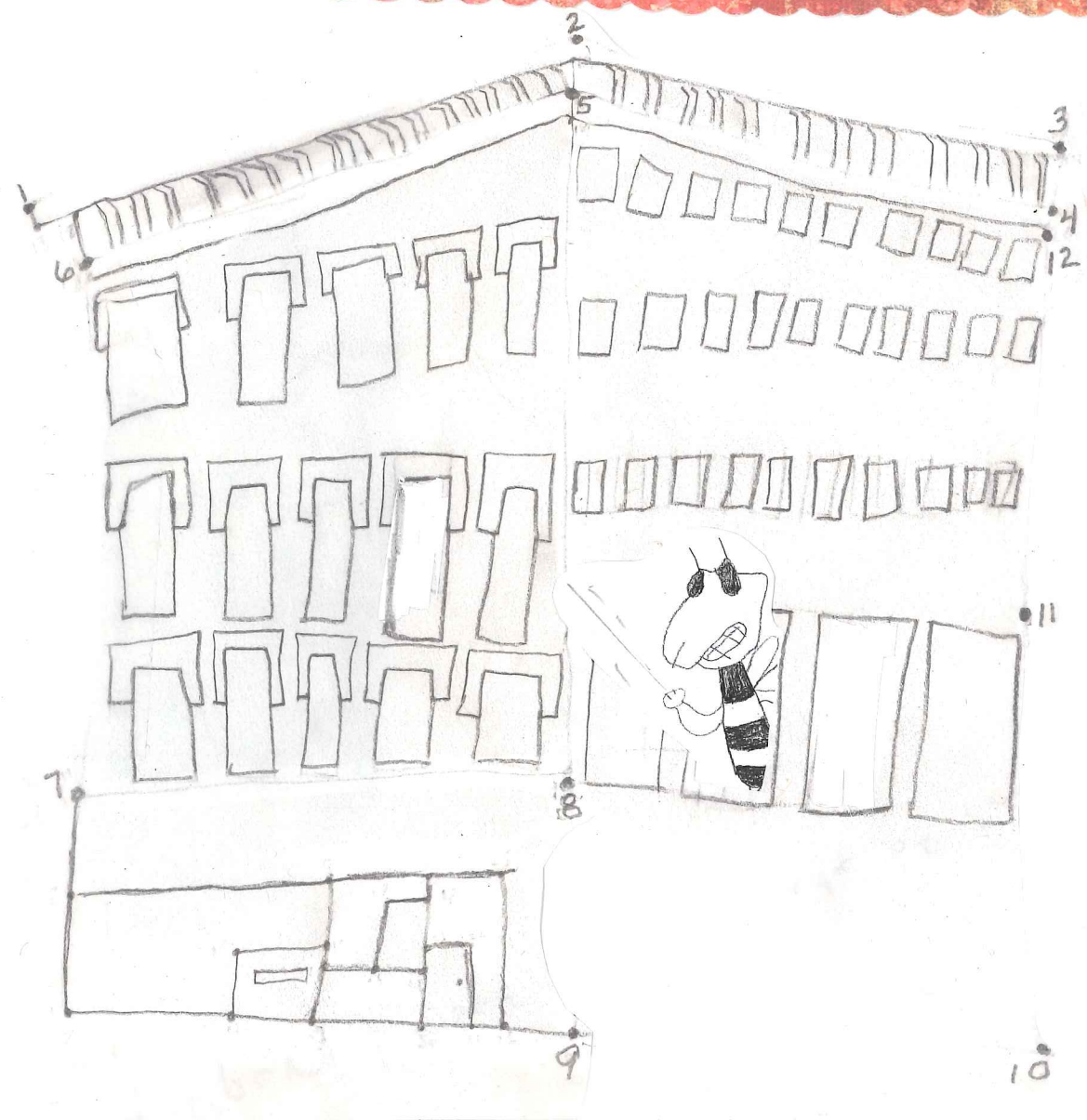
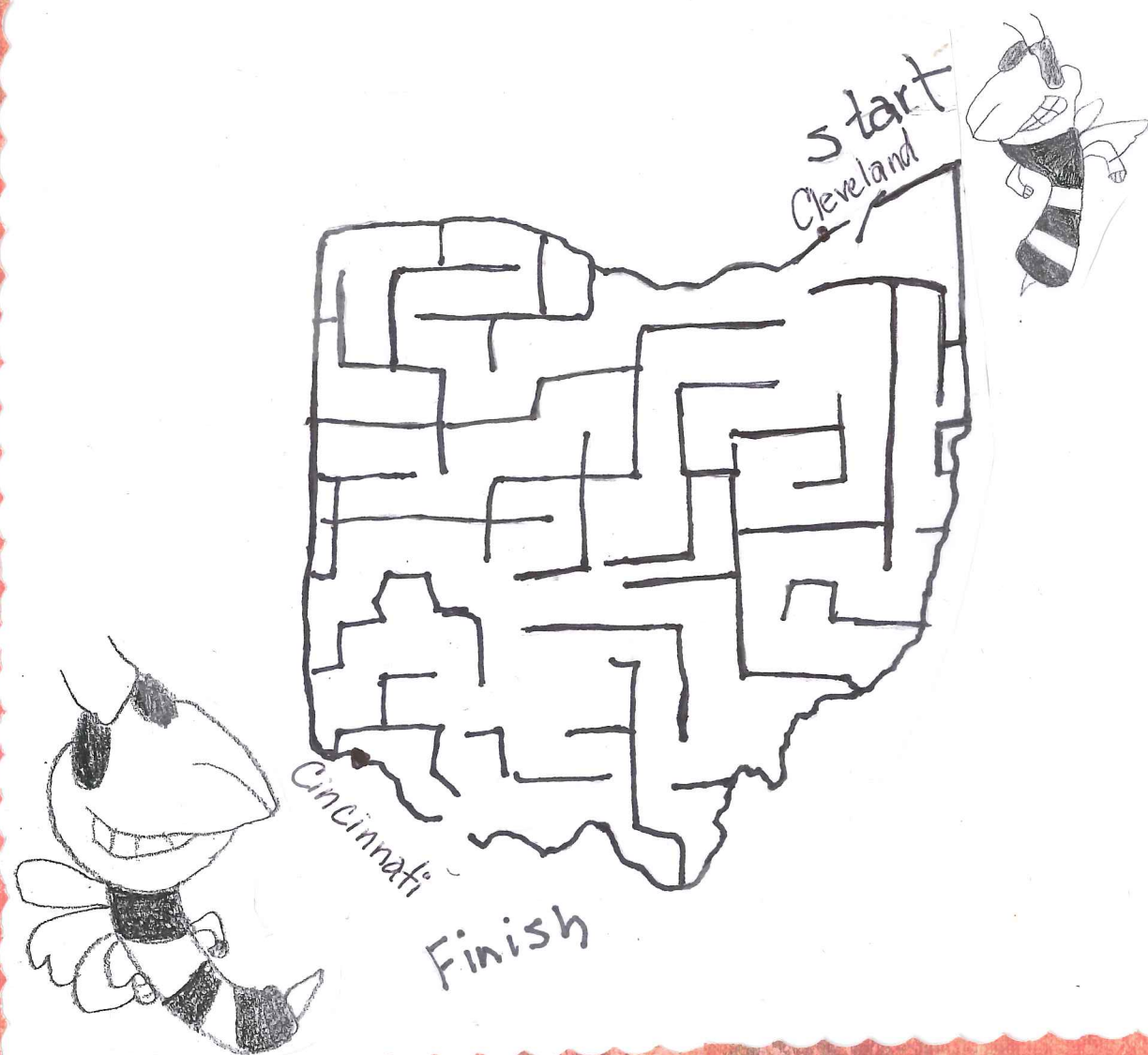


D. Tambourine *The tambourine was not always played.*

The Woodward Opera House

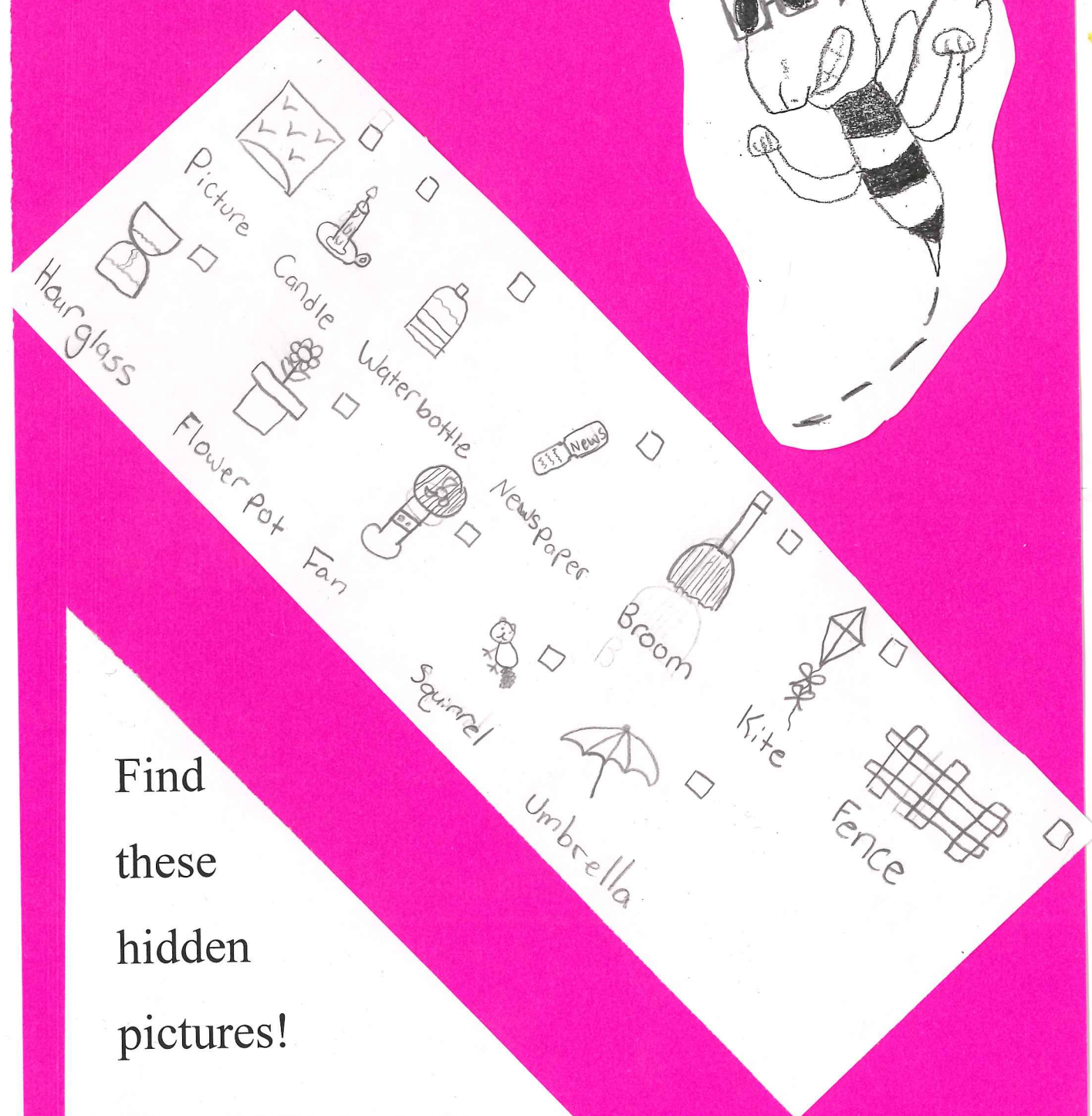
The Woodward Opera House is 163 years old! The Stage is made of iron and wood. It is to be reopened in the year 2016 or in the year 2017.

Complete the dot to dot, from number 1 through 12, to make the Opera House complete!



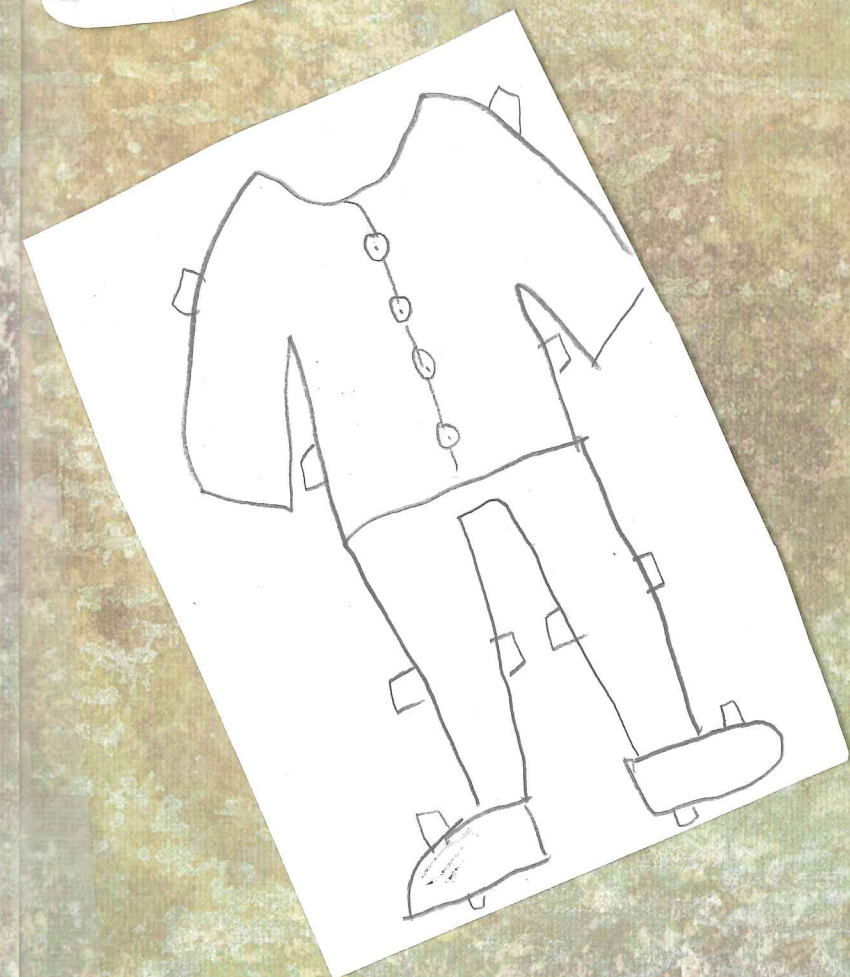
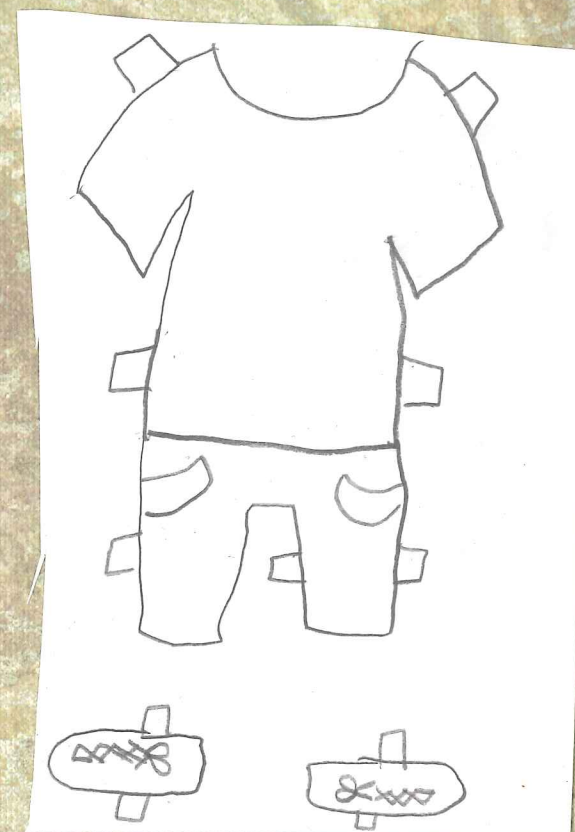
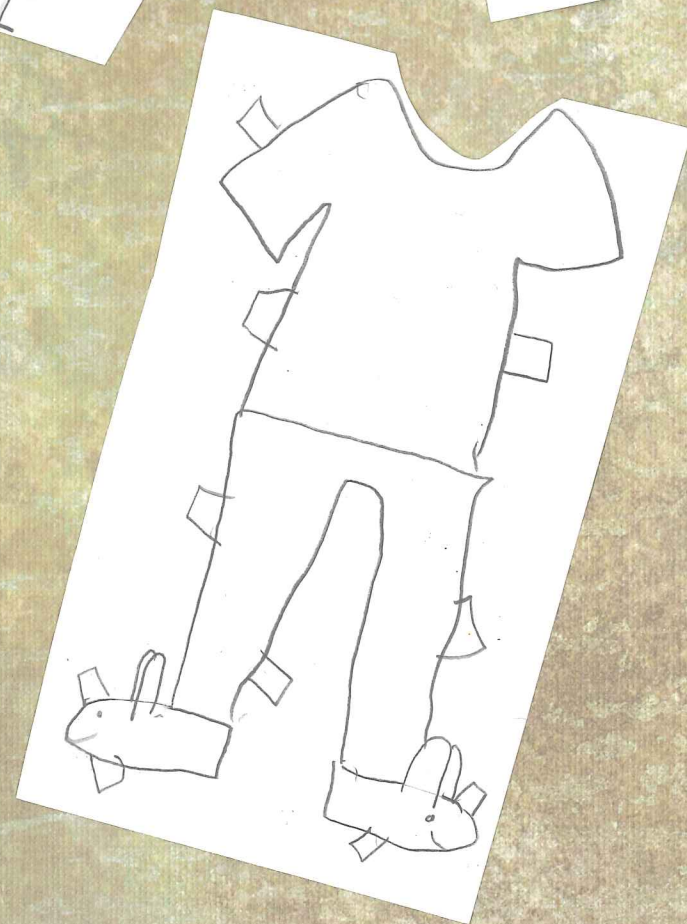
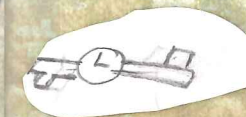
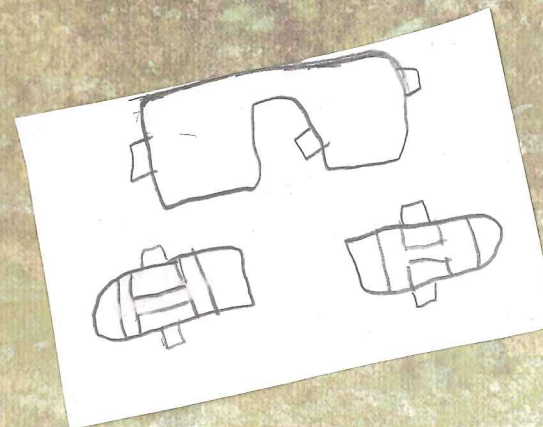
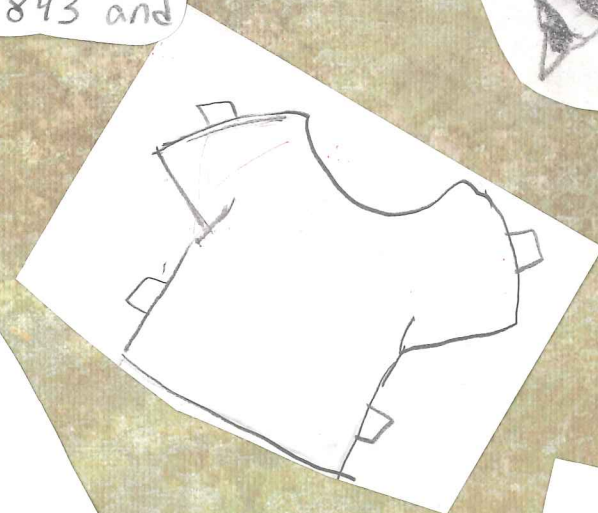
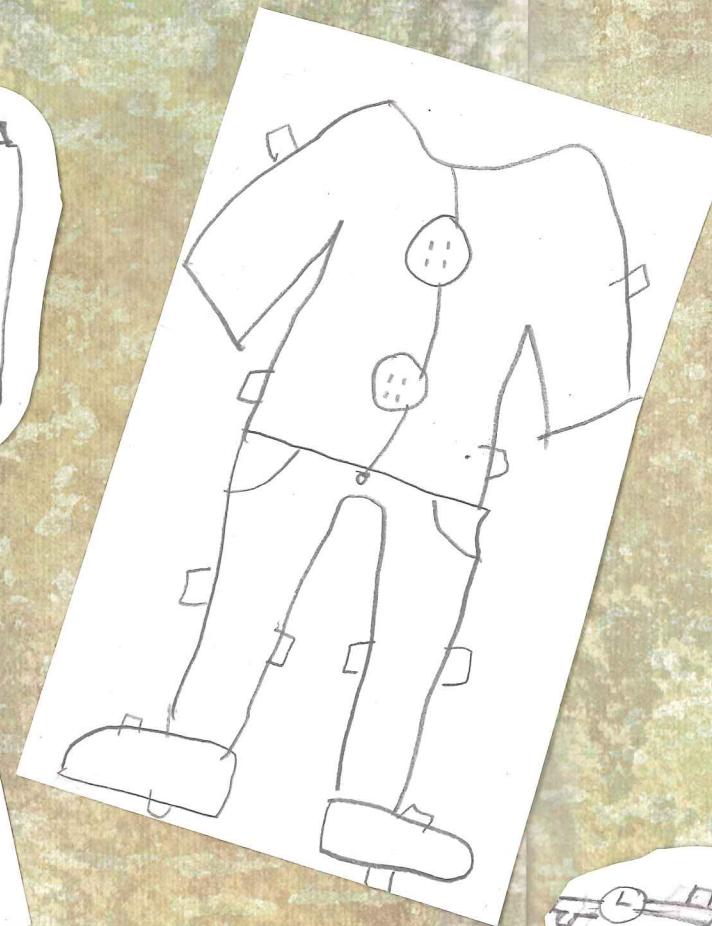
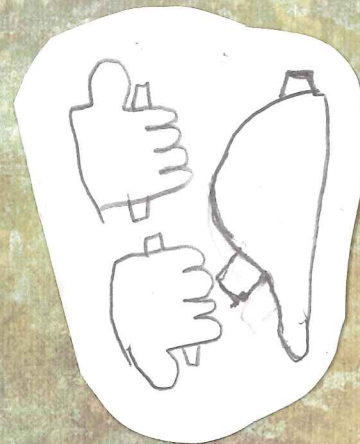
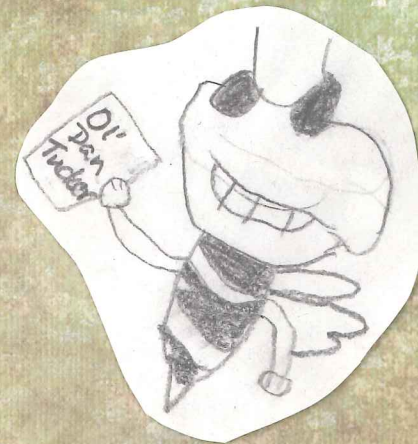
A Henry B. Curtis Home

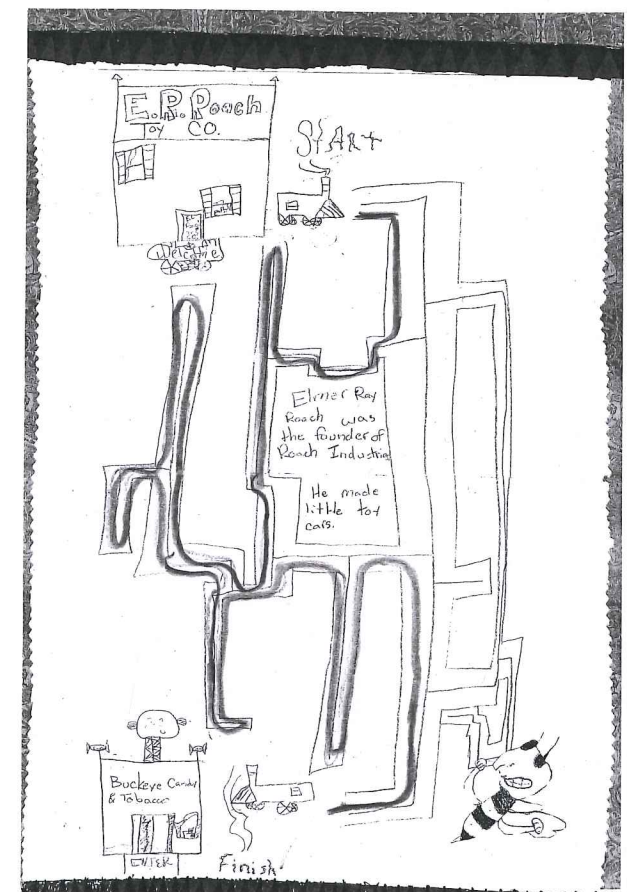
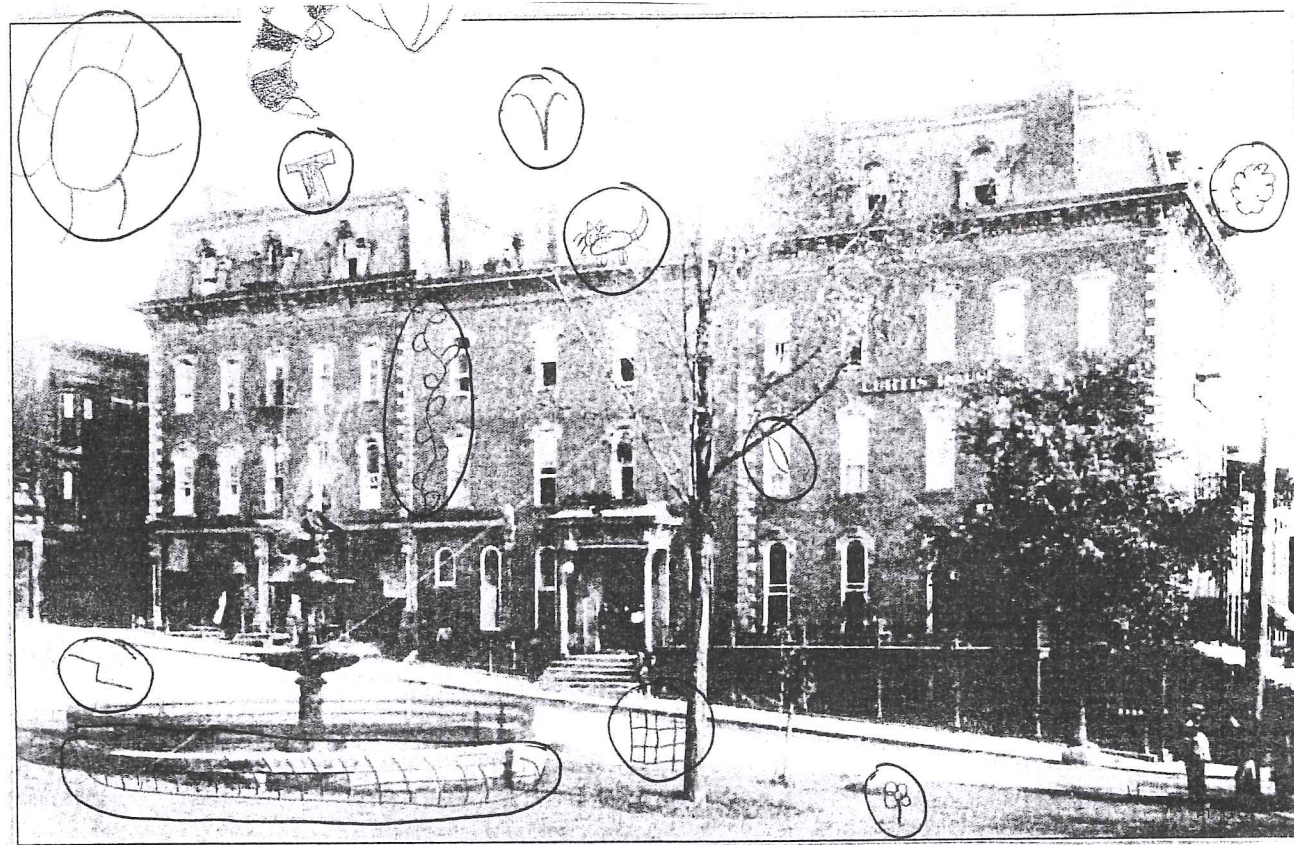
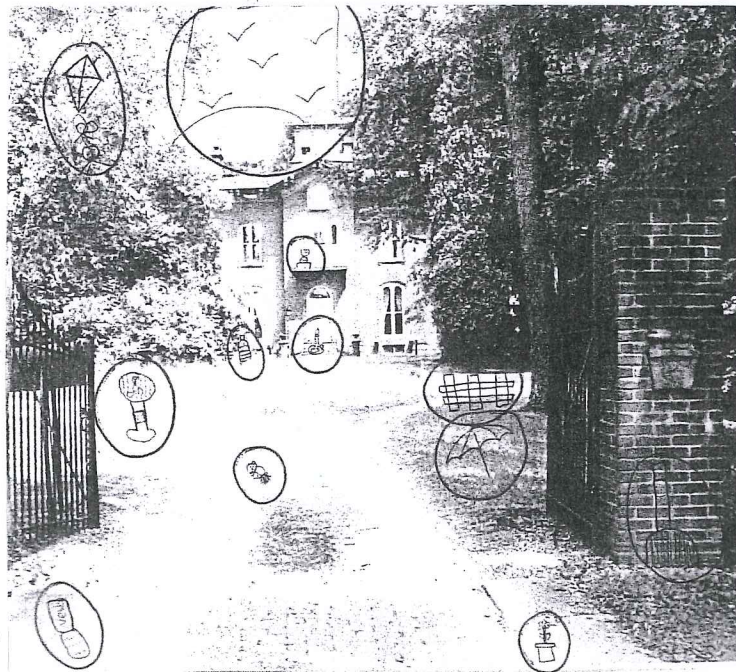


Time to dress up Dan Emmett! Color and cut out the clothes and the Dan doll, put what you want on Dan, and fold back the tabs.
